WASHINGTON CO. CSEA TO OFFER A LICENSE REINSTATEMENT PROGRAM

MARIETTA (OH) – July 20, 2011 – During the month of August 2011, the Washington County Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) is giving obligors an opportunity to get their licenses reinstated.

As part of its observance of Child Support Awareness month, the Washington County CSEA wishes to inform those individuals who have lost their driving privileges, their occupational or recreational licenses as a result of non-payment of support, they are now eligible to have their license reinstated during the month of August. To get your license reinstated you must make a payment that is equal to one full months obligation. Payments may be made at the Washington County CSEA, 205 Putnam St., Courthouse, 4th Floor, Marietta, OH. Payments may also be made with a check or money order if mailing to the agency. Checks and money orders must be made payable to Ohio CSPC. Be sure to include your case number and reference this notice or simply write “amnesty” on your payment. Only cash payments will be processed at the Washington County CSEA.

“Providing a one time opportunity for obligors to get their license reinstated can benefit both parties” said Barb Tergolina, Washington County CSEA Director, “It allows the obligors a means to seek work during the time of unemployment. It also provides support to the family that may not otherwise receive a child support payment due to the obligor being unemployed”.
