**PRIVATE AND COMMERCIAL
DRIVEWAY PERMIT**

**APPLICATION AND PERMIT FOR PRIVATE OR COMMERCIAL DRIVEWAY
TO ACCESS A COUNTY HIGHWAY**

The landowner named on this permit understands that he is required by Ohio Revised Code Sec. 5543.16 to obtain an access permit and is not allowed to obstruct the highway or highway drainage. The property owner further understands he is responsible for the cost of the driveway approach and pipe as well as the maintenance and repair. If the driveway approach is reconstructed as part of a public improvement, it will be done at public expense.

It is understood that the landowner will furnish and have on site a culvert which the Washington County Highway Department will place if requested. Also the property owner will reimburse the Washington County Engineer's Office for a nominal load of six (6) tons of aggregate to cover culvert installation.

Size and Type of culvert to be installed. Note: The culvert shall be a minimum of 12 inches in diameter and at least 20 feet in length. Commercial culverts shall be a minimum of 40 feet in length. Material and size of culvert must be approved by the County Engineer. Material recommended is Galvanized Corrugated Metal Pipe, Double Wall Plastic Pipe or Reinforced Concrete Pipe. All culverts shall have a minimum of 1 foot cover above pipe.
