Permitting under the following conditions:

Permits **not** needed:

- Stream dredging, keep equipment on the bank and pile debris out of the flood plain.
- Stream bank stabilization, place suitable material such as rock or broken concrete at the maximum rate of 1 cu yd per running foot not to exceed 500 linear ft.
- Log jam removal, keep equipment out of the stream & debris is stockpiled out of the floodplain.

Permits **are** needed:

- If equipment will be in the stream.
 - If stabilizing more than 1 cu yd per running foot or exceed 500 linear feet.
