

POLICY 11

All persons convicted of a crime in the Washington County Court of Common Pleas shall be eligible to serve as a trustee while serving their sentence in the Washington County Jail unless the Court prohibits their service as a trustee at the time of sentencing. The Washington County Sheriff's Office shall have the exclusive option to approve persons convicted of a crime in The Washington County Court of Common Pleas, that are not barred by the Court, to work as a supervised trustee inside and outside of the jail. Each trustee shall receive a one day credit against their sentence for each 7 days of work they complete as trustee. A day is defined as one calendar day regardless of the number of hours worked. This policy shall only apply to those inmates serving their entire sentence in the Washington County Jail.
