Notice of Opportunity for Public Input/Comment Wood-Washington-Wirt Interstate Planning Commission

Fiscal Years 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program

The Wood-Washington-Wirt Interstate Planning Commission (WWW) has prepared a Draft Biennial Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the four years 2021-2024. The TIP provides a list of transportation projects in the study area that are programmed to receive federal authorization for implementation during the four-year period covered by the TIP. The types of work included on the TIP are highway and transit projects, as well as projects that provide for bicycle and pedestrian improvements. The study area covered by the TIP includes Wood County, West Virginia and portions of Washington County, Ohio.
